

Fishing regulations

- Fishing spots are assigned, and the assigned number must be observed.
- You must be in possession of a valid fishing permit.
- People under the age of 18 are only admitted under the supervision of an adult.
- Arrival at the fishing spot starts at 1 pm.
- On the day of departure, you must leave the fishing spot before 11:00 am.
- The fishing spot must be kept tidy during the stay, and must be left in a tidy condition upon departure.
- A maximum of 2 anglers per fishing spot are allowed.
- A maximum of 3 rods per person may be used.
- Campers, bungalow tents and/or caravans are prohibited at a fishing spot.
- You can park up to one private car per fishing spot.
- The bivvy must be green or camouflaged.
- Dogs are prohibited.
- Open fire is strictly prohibited.
- The use of a radio is permitted, provided that others are not inconvenienced.
- Rubber boats can only be used on the big lake.
- Rubber boats may only be propelled by an electric motor.
- Lifejackets are mandatory when using a boat.
- Bait boats (radiographic) may be used.
- Wading suits may be used (not in the boat).
- You must be in possession of a scoop net with a minimum span of 90 cm.
- You must be in possession of a large unhooking mat.
- Marker rods are permitted (no floating markers with rope).
- You must be in possession of clinic to tend to any fish wounds.
- Caught fish may only be bagged during the night hours (maximum of 8 hours).
- Grass carp must immediately be returned to the water (no bagging).
- Checks of the materials, particle bait, boilies and so forth can and may be performed by overseers/security staff employed by Libéma at all times.
- All people who visit our park are deemed to be aware of the applicable "Regulations" and are bound by them. Park staff is authorised to remove from the premises or deny access to the premises to any person who does not comply with these rules or who otherwise disturbs or disrupts the smooth running of the park, without refund of any rent paid. If the fishing spot is not left on time, it will be cleared at your cost without liability on our part. This also applies to incorrect setup.
- Carper security
- Holiday Park Beekse Bergen is aware of the risk of carper trade/fish theft.
- For this reason, active security is present at the Holiday Park Beekse Bergen premises. Checks of the content of cars leaving the premises are possible and are performed by overseers/security-staff employed by Libéma. All cases of theft will be reported to the police.
